# In Rememberance

Robert Egger, Jr.  
April 21, 1933 – May 25, 2025

Robert “Bob” Egger, a lifelong San Diegan and proud member of the San Diego Swiss Club, passed away peacefully at home on, at the age of 92.

Robert was the eldest son of Swiss immigrants, Robert Sr. and Emma Egger. Bob grew up alongside his siblings Walter and Mary on the family dairy, which was the foundation of the Egger legacy.

Bob attended the Army Navy Academy followed by Cal Poly University, where he studied Agriculture. In 1954, he combined his studies and his farming roots to co-found the Egger & Ghio Company, a produce growing and distribution business that operated in the San Diego South Bay areas.

His father’s role as a founding member of the San Diego Swiss Club shaped Bob’s identity as a proud Swiss-American. In his youth, Bob was a competitor in the Swiss wrestling sport, “Schwingen”. After hanging up his “Schwinghosen”, Bob could always be found at the judge’s table. He was a Lifetime Honorary Member and a respected Director on the Board of the San Diego Swiss Club.

Bob is survived by Estela, his devoted wife of 50 years, his children - Steve, Danny (deceased), Debbie, Donna, Kathy, David, Cindy, Diane, his stepchildren - Bobby and Jenny along with 28 grandchildren and 40 great-grandchildren. He leaves behind a large and loving family, who will carry on his legacy and traditions.

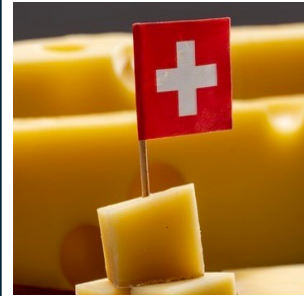

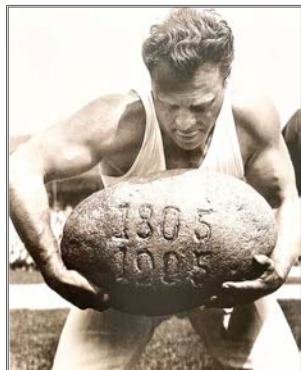

# Steinstossen 2024

Swiss Traditional Rock Throw



“Steinstossen”, Stone throwing is a centuries-old Swiss Alpine traditional sport.

Competitors hurl a huge stone into a designated area. The winner, being the one throwing the stone the longest distance in the best of 3 rounds. Stones used at festivals are of varying weights. The largest stone used is the famed “Unspunnenstein” weighing 184 pounds which is only used every three years at the “Eidgenössisches” Schwingfest and every six years at the “Unspunnenfest”.



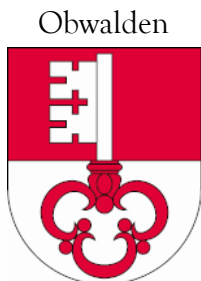
