It was one of her favorite places to be. She also participated with the Swiss Club events in Chino, Imperial Valley and Whittier, Ca. Her family were one of the founding members of the St. Charles Church. Trudy was a very hard-working independent woman, she worked as a seamstress at Ratner's in Chula Vista for several years then moved to Poway where she found a job in the medical field. While there she helped in raising her grandson, Jordan. Trudy enjoyed spending time with her son Paul and grandson. Walter Egger (90 yrs)

Walt of San Diego, passed away peacefully on April 5, 2026. Many remember him as the Swiss Park's resident alphorn player. He was born to Robert Egger Sr. and Emma Egger (Studer) and stayed closely connected to his Swiss roots his entire life. He continued running Egger Dairy in the South Bay, carrying on the tradition started by his father.

Walt was a lifetime member and heavily involved with the Swiss Club. He and his wife Marianne spent many years on the Sunshine Committee, visiting elderly or sick members, talking, singing, and often playing the alphorn to lift their spirits. Walt also oversaw the Steinstossen(stone toss) at the annual Schwingfest. Walt loved music, people, and being part of the community. With the San Diego Swiss Singers, he and Marianne performed in the 1984 Olympics opening ceremonies and well as many Sangerfests and Swiss Club concerts.

They also performed and rode on the Rose Parade float in 1991 for Switzerland's 700th birthday. He was a familiar face at events—whether playing the alphorn, singing at the Schwingfest, or playing accordion and singing songs late into the evening after 1st of August celebrations.



Rick Odermatt (62 yrs)

Rick was born in San Diego, the youngest of Paul and Mary Odermatt's five children. His deep sense of loyalty and devotion made him a dedicated father, husband, and friend. After graduating from UCSD, he went on to build a 40+ year-long career in software engineering, which allowed him to travel the world. Rick was also a lifelong member of

the San Diego Swiss Club, from his early years spent as a Schwinger to his time as a board member and volunteer. It was a place where he loved reconnecting with family and friends. An avid sportsman, he spent much of his time outdoors—waterskiing, hiking, playing volleyball, paddleboarding, and biking—and always invited others to join in on the activities. He passed away suddenly while mountain biking at Picacho State Park, a place he truly loved. He is deeply missed by his wife of 31 years, Kat, his daughter Rachel, and his siblings, cousins, and many friends.

Summer on the Alps

A Tradition as Proud as Schwingen



For centuries, Swiss farmers have moved their cows from the valleys up into the Alps for the summer. What began as a practical way to use every part of their land has become one of Switzerland's most charming and beloved traditions. In summer, the valley fields are needed to grow and dry grass for winter hay, so sending the cows to the high mountain meadows makes perfect sense. Their months on the Alp give them clean air, room to roam, and a rich mix of alpine herbs to graze on. The milk they produce is used to make Alpkäse, with each region offering its own distinctive flavor shaped by the local grasses.

Life on the Alp allows the Senn—the alpine dairy workers—to craft cheese that can only be made on the Alp. Each day after milking, they heat the milk in large copper kettles. The curds are stirred, cut, warmed again, and then pressed into round forms. These wheels of Alpkäse are stored in cool mountain huts. At the end of the season, the cheese is divided among the farmers according to how much milk each cow produced throughout the summer.

The month of September is the typical month for the cows to return home. The Alpbazug, as it is called, is a festive homecoming parade: cows wear large bells and colorful flower crowns, farmers dress in traditional clothing, and entire villages gather to watch them make their way down from the mountains.—this is how farming, culture, and tradition come together in a way that is proudly Swiss.

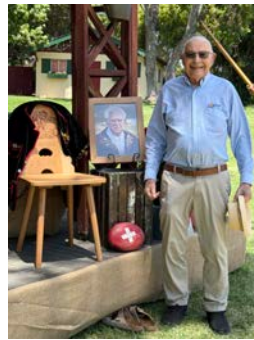


Bob Egger's Tradition Lives On

Bob's children are proud to sponsor the 2026 winner's chair, carrying forward the joy and commitment that Bob showed for so many years.

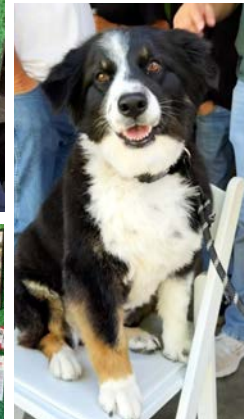
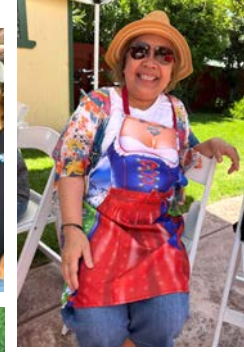
